I am honored to present the report of all the activities undertaken during the academic session 2021-22. We render an interesting and enterprising school year, full of life, innovation, knowledge and experience. I am glad to notify our mark of excellence in our diverse scholastic and co-scholastic scheduling. Education is the foundation of all progress and growth, both as an individual and as a society. The new academic year 2021-22 began on 7th April for class IX & X and from 23rd April for classes I to VIII. The day was commenced with a prayer service. During the phase of lockdown due to Covid -19, we have arranged the virtual online classes for the students by setting their timetable according to the convenience of the students and the siblings in the same family. At the same time teachers were given training to get updated with the modern technology to teach and reach students, without making the learners to feel the absence of their teachers. The out come of these online classes were really satisfactory as we got positive response from the students and parents. Special concern was given to prevent the spread of Covid -19 among staff and students. We have arranged many awareness classes for the staff and students to break the chain of the virus' spread. We also, encouraged both staff and students to get Covid-19 Vaccine.

Scholastic Program

We follow the CCE system devised by CBSE. This evaluation is based on a scholastic performance, leading to the all-round development of the child. Under this scheme, the scholastic part is evaluated by the Periodic assessment and Term Assessment of their performance in core subjects. In the first semester, we conducted Periodic Assessments (PA)1 and Term Assessment I , administering variety of tools namely class tests, quiz, projects, Power point Presentation, seminars etc. in online mode. In the second semester, tests and other assessment conducted in online mode, as part of Term Assessment II , Final Exam (Term II) conducted in the month of March in physical mode. Remedial coaching is undertaken for the students on need basis. The

final exam for the Class X were conducted according to the prescription of the CBSE board. Our students come out with a colorful result. We are proud to mention here that we have harvested a 100% in the CBSE Board Class X, fourth batch 2021-22 exams. Pavan Pahune scored 96.6 %, Soni Kumari came in the second position with 94.4% and Kushi Kharwade bagged the 3rd position with 94.2%. We congratulated all the toppers and all our students who gave an excellent result to our school. We sincerely acknowledge cooperation of the staff, and parents for such excellent achievement even in the midst of Covid -19 Pandemic challenges.
