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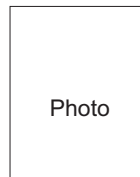

### **General Information :**

#### *The School :*

St. Gianelli Convent School is a Christian Minority Institution administered by the Sisters of Our Lady of the Garden, who have dedicated their lives to God and are committed zealously responding to the needs of the times, rendering devoted service in the field of education and upliftment of Humanity. Our Institution has faithfully adhered to the ideal of 'integration' - trying to bring about a harmonious blendings of the spiritual values with the secular, modernity with heritage, competitiveness with co-operation, technology with humanism, self radiance with social sensitivity.

The school follows CBSE pattern and promotes co-education and admits any child irrespective of caste, creed, colour and religion. The medium of instruction is English and spoken English is given a greater emphasis. It's focus is on the all-round development of the students.

(The school is totally private, un-aided and does not receive any grand-in-aid from any Government).

#### *Aims & Objectives :*

Every school has an objective to fulfill. St. Gianelli Convent School aims at integral development of the pupil through academic excellence, co-curricular activities and conducive atmosphere to bloom and unfold hidden potentialities. The focus of academic activities are towards enrichment of the total personality of the learners :-



- 1) Developing the character of the students with attitudes needed for a balanced, confident mature outgoing and preparations for complete living.
- 2) To instill in them the spirit of nationalism, patriotism and understanding.
- 3) To train them to obey their elders, parents, teachers and further to discipline themselves for hard work, creativity, co-operation, team-work and leadership.
- 4) To inculcate in them the dignity of labour, and speak the truth and to have self-respect and love for others.
- 5) To identify their talents, fields of interest and develop them with able guidance.

### **The Motto**

#### *“Advancing Knowledge - Transforming Lives”*

In this fast changing world, the process of learning and imparting knowledge through a standard pattern of academic and moral education has its own importance for which the school holds out the Motto “Advancing Knowledge Transforming lives”. This school offers her students opportunities for the development of an integrated personality. We aim for excellence in everything in the belief that our children deserve to achieve their full potential.

#### *Admission :*

Admission in school is restricted to the seats available. It is open to all people without any distinction of any class or creed. A pupil who join a fresh from home or from any other school has to produce his/her official birth certificate / transfer certificate in





support of the date of birth entered in the Admission form. Birth certificate issued by the municipal authorities or baptismal certificates shall be held valid. The date of birth as recorded by the authorities shall be considered legally correct and no change or alteration will be allowed later on.

## **Norms**

### ***Admission to Nursery, L.K.G. & U.K.G.***

Children between 3 years / 3½ - Nursery, 3½ years / 4 years - K.G. I and 4½ years / 5 years K.G. II are eligible to apply for admission. Relevant documents (3 recent passport size photograph, Birth Certificate from Municipality / Panchayat, copy of Aadhar Card, Baptismal Certificate duly attested by competent authority) as desired by the school should be produced at the time of admission.

### ***Admission to other classes***

- 1) Transfer Certificate (duly countersigned) 3 recent passport size photographs and original mark sheet, copy of Aadhar Card, should be brought along at the time of admission.
- 2) Admission is incomplete until the school leaving certificate from the last recognized school is produced.

### ***Admission formalities :***

- ❖ A list of selected candidates will be displayed on the school notice board.
- ❖ The selected candidate should come along with both the parents to take admission.
- ❖ A true copy of the marksheet, original T.C. (duly countersigned) two passport size photographs should be brought along.



- ❖ All documents requested for admission become the property of the school and are not returnable on any account. After the pupil qualifies for admission, the birth certificate has to be submitted in original.

### *Withdrawal :*

- 1) A calender months notice is to be given before the withdrawal of a student, failing which a months fee must be paid.
- 2) No Transfer Certificate will be issued unless all school dues and other relevant areas have been paid full in cash.
- 3) Students leaving the school in mid-session shall pay the full fee in cash for the full academic session.

### *Examinations & Promotions :*

- 1) The system of periodical assessment and Terminal Examinations are followed to evaluate the teaching and learning process. Progress reports are issued to the students at the conclusions of PA I, PA II and Terminal Examinations.
- 2) A child will get promotion only if he/she has achieved atleast 35% marks in each subject.
- 3) Attendance at all examinations is compulsory. Promotions will be considered on the basis of the whole years record.
- 4) A minimum attendance of 80% is must through out the year for final promotion.
- 5) There will be no change of the exam date if the student is absent or sick.
- 6) A pupil who uses unfair means or who possesses materials for unfair means and/or receives or gives assistance in any form during examinations will be given a Zero in the subjects. Repetitions of the same, shall lead to dismissal.
- 7) There will be no re-examinations at any time for any reason.



### *Private Tutions:*

As a school policy, private tuition is always discouraged. The teaching in the school is so planned that a child need not go for private tuition. Therefore parents are strictly advised not to engage any teacher either from the school or from outside without consulting the principal.

### *Punctuality:*

- 1) The school gate will be closed at 7.45 a.m. sharp. If the child is late he/she will not be allowed to enter the school and will be considered as absent. If the child is late for assembly he/she will be considered as a late comer.
- 2) Students must arrive at school 5 minutes before the first bell.
- 3) Repeatedly coming late for assembly (5 times) the child is liable to be suspended from the school.

### *Rules concerning Absence & Late coming:*

- 1) Leave of absence will be granted by the principal for serious reasons and only with a prior written application signed by the parents. This should later be entered briefly on the LEAVE - ABSENCE RECORD PAGE OF THE SCHOOL DIARY WHICH HAS TO BE SIGNED BY PARENTS OR GUARDIAN and shown to the class teacher.
- 2) As principle not more than one day leave will be granted for a local wedding of brother or sister or close relative. Leave for wedding outside Nagpur will be granted at the discretion of the principal. For such leave, a written application by the parent should be submitted to the principal one week in advance. The parents should follow-up the school studies missed by their children for such leave period.



- 3) A pupil who has been suffering from infections or contagious disease will not be allowed to attend school.
- 4) Appointments with doctors should be made after school hours.
- 5) Repeated absence without prior sanctions of leave or unexplained absence for more than five consecutive days renders the students liable to have his/her name struck off the rolls. Re-admission, if granted will be done on payment of re-admission fee.
- 6) The school encourages punctuality. Parents are advised to inculcate in their wards the habit of coming early to school. No relaxation to this principle shall be allowed.

## **Disciplinary Action**

### *Attendance :*

- 1) Every student has to attend the school on the re-opening day after each vacation.
- 2) If absent, due to ailment the principal has to be informed and medical certificate should be submitted at the earliest.
- 3) If the parents do not attend minimum two Parent-Teacher Meetings, the student will be liable for dismissal.
- 4) Absence on the days of a school function, be it on working days or holidays or National holidays will incur serious disciplinary action. Similarly, absence from school prior to tests or examinations will incur disciplinary actions.

### *School Calender :*

- 5) The child should bring the school calender daily. Calender must be maintained neat and tidy. A student who loses his/her calender will have to buy a new one.



### *Uniform :*

- 6) Those who come to school without proper uniform or the school calendar will after three warnings be sent home and marked absent.

### *Behaviour :*

- 7) Every student should endeavour to keep the good behaviour and polite manners, both in and outside the school. They should remember that the school is judged by their conduct.
- 8) No pupil may leave the school premises during working hours without the written permission of the school authorities. Students who violate this rule will be suspended or dismissed from the school.
- 9) Irregular attendance, disobedience or conduct harmful to the moral tone of the school, disrespect to Principal, teachers, non-teaching staff, office bearers and any authority, will either be suspended or summarily dismissed.
- 10) The Principal will take confidential report from teachers regarding the conduct and behaviour of students and on the basis of these reports may ask the parents to withdraw his/her child from the school. The decision of the principal shall be final.

### *School Fee :*

- 1) The school shall charge the full fee for the students, but for the convenience of the parents the fee is divided into monthly instalments. Parents are free to deposit the full fee in one instalment.
- 2) Students shall get their NO DUES CERTIFICATE cleared before appearing in every Terminal Examinations. No student will be allowed to appear in the Terminal examination if he/she fails to clear his/her dues. To avoid inconvenience, parents are requested to check the fee book regularly.



- 3) Students leaving the school in mid-session shall pay the full fee for the full academic sessions.
- 4) No reduction shall be made for vacation or broken period.
- 5) For issuing duplicate T.C. / Report Card Fees will be charged.
- 6) All those who complete their wards school fees at a time, at the time of First Installment, an amount of ₹500 will be given as concession.

*Note:*

- ❖ Loose socks should be replaced by a new one instead of using rubber band.
- ❖ Nor ornaments / jewelleryes whatsoever, are to be worn by the students except for small earrings. In case of any loss of valuables, the school will not be responsible.
- ❖ **Hair Style :** Boys hair must be properly cut and trimmed. Girls having short hair must make a pony tail with ribbon and those with very short hair must use a hair band.
- ❖ Nails must be short and clean. Use of nail polish Mehendi on hands, feet, palm etd. are strictly prohibited.

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- 2) To instill in them the spirit of nationalism, patriotism and understanding.



- (j) Any pupil who is seriously ill or suffering from any infectious or contagious disease should not be sent to school. If he/she is likely to be absent from school for three or more days, the principal should be informed at once. On recovery, he/she must submit a doctors certificate stating that the child is fully cured.
- (k) Leave taken for mere functions are not recommended because it affects the progress of the child and may result in failure on all fronts. No child would avail leave without the prior permission of the principal.
- (l) Parents are also expected to co-operate with the school authorities by taking an active and helpful interest in the activities of the school.
- (m) Please ensure that your child does not carry sharp, pointed or other dangerous / costly articles, CD, Mobile Phones, Jewellery to the school.
- (n) While communicating with the Principal through letter, parents are requested to mention the name, class and section of their children and telephone number.
- (o) Phone calls will be entertained only during the office hours.
- (p) Parents/Guardians are not allowed to meet the teachers at their residence for discussion of any matters related to the curricular and co-curricular activities of their ward in the school.

### *Word to Students :*

- 1) All of you are expected to conduct yourself as responsible persons at all times and in all places. The power of the Principal to correct an erring pupil is the same as that of a Parent.  
The school will insist on strict punctuality, regular attendance, cleanliness in person and dress, general grooming and fidelity to study and work assignments.





- 2) You all must arrive at the school atleast five minutes before the first bell.
- 3) At the first bell, all must immediately line up according to their classes for the morning assembly.
- 4) During the assembly, you all should recite the prayers and sing hymns. Thereafter you must go to your respective classes in silence. Running, shouting, hooting or whistling shall lead to disciplinary action.
- 5) The school calendar should be brought to school daily. It should be used to note down the daily home-work and other instructions by the teachers.
- 6) Personal cleanliness is expected from all of you. The school uniform worn by you must be clean, neatly ironed, shoes polished, finger nails clipped and hair neatly combed. Discoloured uniform, worn-out socks and shoes should be avoided. A pupil may be sent home for lack of personal cleanliness, long hair (for boys) dirty clothes and shoes, after a warning in the school calendar.
- 7) After leaving the classroom for physical training, games or library you all must walk along the corridors and the stairs in single line and in perfect silence, bearing in mind the rule **“Keep Left”**.
- 8) Students are not allowed to remain in the class room during recess or G.P.T. periods. The monitors shall close the door after the students leave.
- 9) Pupils must attend physical education, games and other activities outside the class room. Once on the play ground, nobody may returns to the class room without permission. You should leave the ground 5 minutes before the bell for the next period.
- 10) As the medium of instruction is English, you all must communicate in English at all times as long as you are in the school premises. Parents should encourage their children to respond in English and increase their fluency.
- 11) Besides the subject copies, text books and school library books, no other books (Novels, Comics, Slam Book, Magazines, Newspapers etc.) are to be brought to school. You are forbidden to bring Mobile Phones, Sharp pointed



weapons and other dangerous materials to school.

- 12) The school will not be responsible for the loss of money, books, fountain pens, watches or other valuable articles of the students.
- 13) Students are divided under four houses in the school : **Blue, Green, Red, Yellow.**
- 14) No student shall enter the school campus without the school uniform during working hours even when one is on leave including Parent-Teacher Meet.
- 15) Health is wealth. So you all should bring nutritious tiffin and not depend on fast food.

### *Co-curricular Activities :*

This school strives for the overall development of the child. Hence, co-curricular activities are regularly organized for various classes throughout the year. Students are expected to take initiative and take part in these activities. Parents should encourage their wards to participate actively. The individual talents of the children may be brought to the notice of the principal / teacher so that proper backup and encouragement may be given to them students also will be evaluated on the basis of their interest, involvement and performance in these activities during the co-curricular activity period.

### *The House System :*

One of the main objectives of the house system is to foster in the students a sense of collective responsibility and solidarity and at the same time enkindle and develop the social qualities and talents in every child. It is the house system that channelises discipline in the school and school-life with all its complex, curricular and co-curricular activities. It also directs and energises the talents of our students.

Students are divided under four houses in the school : **Blue, Green, Red, Yellow.**
